Dear Parents/Carers,

As we come to the end of a long and busy term, I want to thank all parents and carers for your continued support. We also celebrated the achievements of our Class of 2025 at our GCSE Celebrations Awards, including this year's scholarship winners, Thazkiyra and Nathan.

Our students have shown great commitment, enthusiasm and resilience throughout the term, and we are proud of everything they have accomplished. Thank you to our staff for their dedication and to families for working closely with us.

GCSE Results- We are delighted to share that our students have achieved some of the best GCSE results in Tower Hamlets (see attached).

Bangladesh Trip- We are excited to announce another International Visit to Bangladesh for our Year 10 students at the end of December. During the visit, students will visit local schools in Sylhet, take part in charity work and explore historical sites, making this a memorable and educational experience. Students are eagerly looking forward to the trip, and we are delighted to support them in preparing for this enriching opportunity. This trip will be from **Wednesday 31st December - Monday 12th January 2026**.

Foodbank- Thank you to everyone who contributed to the foodbank. Your donations will go to Tower Hamlets and will help support those in need, especially during this time of year.

School Closure for Christmas Holidays- The school will close on Friday 19th December. Friday will be a non-uniform day. Students who wish to take part should contribute £1, with all proceeds going towards donations for local communities in Bangladesh. Students who choose to wear their school uniform do not need to pay a fee. Year 7 & 8 will be dismissed at 12:40pm. Year 9 will be dismissed at 12:45pm. Year 10 and 11 will be dismissed at 12:50pm. Students will be offered a packed lunch or the option to eat in the canteen, should they wish.

School Reopening in January 2026- We have a staff training day on Monday, 5th January. **The school will reopen for all students on Tuesday, 6th January at 8:40 am.**

Holiday Homework- Teachers have set homework and online tasks for students. Pupils can access online lessons through Oak National Academy and BBC Bitesize to revise areas they may be struggling with or to catch up on missed content. Please check Show My Homework for all assigned work.

School Places in Year 7, 8 & 9- If you know of any families seeking a secondary school place, please direct them to our school, as we currently have a few places available in Years 7, 8, and 9.

Mobile Phones- Mobile phones are not allowed in school and should not be seen on the school site. Any phones that are seen will be confiscated and returned to parents on Friday after school between 3:15 pm and 4:30 pm. The school cannot accept responsibility for any phones that are lost or damaged.



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Uniform- We are a uniform school, and all pupils are expected to adhere to the school dress code. This includes wearing school shoes and ties, and not wearing jewellery, makeup, or having inappropriate haircuts. Blazers and ties can be purchased from Ocean Design, 10 Watney Street, London E1 2PR (020 7702 8881).

Detentions - We have high expectations for behaviour in school and around the school site at all times. *“The school works with pupils to help them to achieve academic success. It supports pupils to make sure that they seize every opportunity that is offered to them. Staff inspire pupils to positively contribute to society, for example by taking part in charitable work.”* (Ofsted, October 2024).

To support these expectations, the school operates detentions at break and lunchtime for minor infringements, lateness and corridor slips. After-school detentions also run daily. **Parents and carers will be notified of any detention lasting longer than 30 minutes.**

Staying safe online - We encourage parents to monitor what their child is doing online at home, whether on iPads, laptops, gaming consoles (PS4/5), or mobile phones. The school has a strict filtering system in place to ensure pupils access safe and appropriate content online.

Afterschool Clubs - We run a variety of clubs throughout the week, including Football, Badminton, Table Tennis, Homework, and Intervention sessions. Please check with your child for specific days and times. The school library is open every day before school, at break and lunchtime, and after school until 4:30 pm for pupils to use.

Saturday school 10am to 1:00pm - Our Saturday School is running for Year 11 interventions in English, Maths, and Science, as well as SATs booster sessions for Year 6 pupils. These courses are free of charge. Please contact the school for further details. In addition, we provide daily after-school intervention for Year 11s in all subjects, and pupils are expected to stay behind to attend these sessions.

Year 11 Holiday Intervention- The Year 11 Holiday Intervention sessions will take place on Monday 22nd, Tuesday 23rd, and Wednesday 24th, from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Breakfast Club- The Academy runs a Breakfast Club from 8:00 am to 8:30 am, Monday to Friday. It is open to all students, who are welcome to enjoy a **free breakfast** if they wish. A variety of options is available, including toast, cereals, and fruit.

Winter Multi Sports Camp in partnership with London Sportif- Year 6 only – Fun Arts & Crafts activities. Contact the school for spaces. Camp runs 22–31 December 10am–3pm (excluding Christmas Day & Boxing Day).
